



HAWAII LABORERS' APPRENTICESHIP & TRAINING



Seeking Environmental Apprentices
(Hazardous Waste Material Technician)

Recruitment for OAHU only

Applicants must meet the minimum qualifications for apprenticeship as listed below:

- 1) Must be a minimum of (18) years of age.
- 2) Must provide a high school diploma or GED equivalent *preferred*, or high school transcript showing proof of completion of a 10th grade education.
(Acceptable documents: Letter from high school (must be on school letterhead stating individual did graduate with graduation date), Military discharge paper (DD214), college transcript or diploma.)
- 3) Must provide a valid driver's license when submitting an application and at the start of the 3 day pre-environmental evaluation course.

Other requirements:

- Must become a member of the Hawaii Laborers' Union, Local 368
- Term of apprenticeship shall be on the island of Oahu

Additional contractor requirements prior to start of employment:

- Must be able to pass a physical & drug test
- Must be able to use and pass a respiratory fit test
- Must be able to work in a tyvek protective suit
- Must complete a respiratory medical questionnaire
- Must be able to work at night and weekends when required

Applicants are required to register online at hiltp.org; only those who have registered online will be invited to submit an application.

Apprentice wages start at \$18.20 and hour
